

SUTTERBY FIELDWALKING (SCF14) - THE POTTERY

INTRODUCTION

The material was laid out and viewed in transect/stint order. The pottery pieces (sherds) were identified and then counted by individual transect/stint number. Pottery was examined visually and using x20 magnification. This information was then added to an Access database. A full list of the pottery is included in Table 2 below, with a summary of types show in Table 1. The pottery codenames (Cname) used, are in accordance with the Post Roman pottery type series for Lincolnshire, as published in Young *et al.* (2005).

THE POTTERY

This is a relatively large assemblage to have been recovered from a single area and it includes pottery from a surprisingly broad range of periods.

There are four definite fragments of prehistoric pottery (PREH, IA), including grog and shell tempered types. A further nine pieces of shell tempered pottery are included within the group recorded as unidentifiable miscellaneous (MISC); this most probably also includes Iron Age shelly wares. Four additional sand tempered sherds (HMIAAS) could be either Iron Age or Early to middle Saxon in date.

There are four fragments of Early to middle Saxon pottery and one of later Saxon date, with a range of fabrics recorded. The presence of both Prehistoric and early to middle Saxon dated ceramics here is of great interest. These types are not common and under normal circumstances, they are unlikely to travel far from the place of deposition.

The Medieval pottery is dominated by products from the kilns at Toynton all Saints (TOY), with this material accounting for 44% of all sherds. This is unsurprising given the close proximity of Sutterby to Toynton. A smaller number of other types were also noted, including 22 fragments of Bourne Medieval ware (BOUA), Lincoln glazed ware (LSW), Stamford ware (ST) and Early Medieval shell tempered ware (LEMS). Virtually none of the Bourne wares are glazed and it may well be that most of this material dates to before the foundation of the kilns at Toynton, which occurred in around 1280 AD. Although factories at both Toynton and Bourne produced pottery throughout the 14th century the Bourne producers are known to have begun much earlier than this, with unglazed types made Bourne and distributed away from the town from at least AD 1150, if not earlier.

There is a high number of sherds of post medieval, 16th to 18th century date, with brown and black glazed earthenwares (BERTH, BL), as well as glazed and unglazed red earthenwares (GRE, PMED), particularly well represented. Some of this material will include late and Post Medieval Toynton types, although only a few sherds of this, recorded here as Toynton Bolingbroke type, could be confidently identified as such.

There is a notably small amount of 19th to 20th century dated pottery; this maybe because of changes in land use at that time.
